“Is anything too hard for the Lord?...”

Genesis 18:14 (NIV)

Dear Friends,

As we come into this season of prayer and fasting, I want to remind you of God’s words in Genesis 18. Let me give you the context. Abraham & Sarah had been waiting for a long time for God to give them a child. God promised them that they would have a son together, and that all peoples on earth would be blessed through their family tree. (See Genesis 12:3) What God had promised seemed physically impossible not only because Sarah couldn’t conceive, but by this time she was around 90 years old. When God was having a conversation with Abraham, He told Abraham that by this time next year Sarah will have a son. When Sarah heard this, she laughed in disbelief and God asked why she didn’t believe, saying “Is anything too hard for the Lord?”

Is there something that you’ve been believing God for that just seems

- impossible?
- a healing in your body
 - deliverance from an addiction or life controlling problem
 - provision
 - a restored relationship
 - a wayward child

- unsaved family members

Ask yourself this question. “Is there anything too hard for the Lord?” Well is there? (The answer is no) Be encouraged by the Word of God...

“All things are possible” Matthew 19:26

“Nothing is impossible with God.” Luke 1:37

“I know that you (God) can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted”-Job 42:2 “All things are possible for one who believes.”-Mark 9:23

“What is impossible with men is possible with God.”-Luke 18:27

“Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us”-Ephesians 3:20

I could go on and on but you get the idea right? There’s nothing that our God can’t do! Over the next twenty-one days our church is going to purposely set aside time to spend with God. Jesus said in Matthew 6 that we should seek God first, and we’re going to do that through prayer, daily bible reading, fasting, and corporate worship. I believe that if we shut out the world and all of it’s distractions and seek God, we’re going to experience Him in a fresh new way! - Join us on First Friday Prayer
- Tune into our daily prayer 7pm prayer times on Facebook Live
- Come to the Encounter Revival Nights

Here’s what I know. God is able. What we see Him do in the Bible, He can do it in our life! Let’s seek Him with our whole hearts for the next 21 Days!
